CODE OF CONDUCT OF THE YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD

The following Code of Conduct shall apply to all activities organized by the Youth Advisory Board:

1. SHOPLIFTING will not be tolerated and will result in an automatic suspension from the remainder of the trip. Students found shoplifting will be turned into mall security and will not be allowed to return on the bus with other participants.
2. ANY expression of physical or verbal abuse to any staff member or chaperon will result in automatic suspension from all City sponsored activities, programs, and facilities.
3. Proper identification must be presented upon request by staff member/chaperon.
4. NO loud playing of CD players, MP3 players, etc. will be permitted. Staff or chaperons will determine volume. Abuse will result in property being confiscated.
5. NO alcoholic beverages, drugs, or gambling will be permitted.
6. NO smoking or use of tobacco products will be permitted.
7. NO public displays of affection will be permitted.

Any violation of the Code of Conduct or directives by staff members or chaperons may result in suspension from Youth Advisory Board activities or programs as well as suspension from City recreation facilities and/or activities. Once suspended, you lose the privileges of using the recreation facilities at the Civic Center, Municipal Pool, Scarboro Community Center, parks, etc. (including league play at all locations) for the duration of the suspension.
